

Artificial Intelligence is not new


Artificial Intelligence (AI) has existed for thousands of years.




Older examples can be found in ancient cultures, such as the Roman empire.




A government collects information into archives and makes decisions based on this information.

Just like a government would be. Maybe the governance of Rome was Jupiter himself?






I guess artificial intelligence is nothing new
