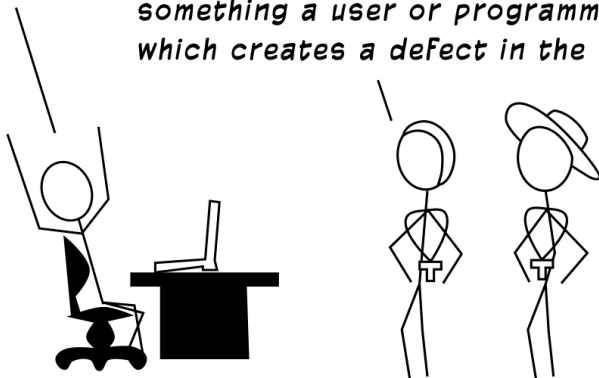


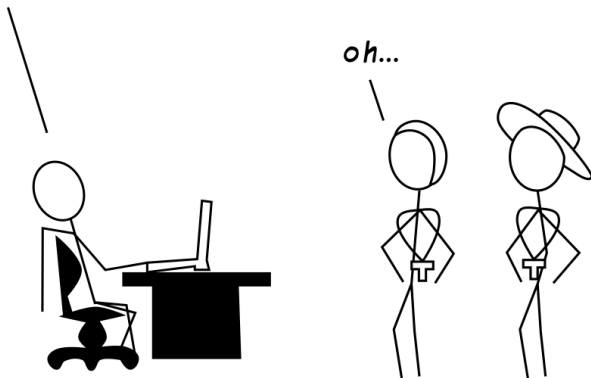
Testing ISTQB
